Home to one of the largest shrimp companies in the region, Bon Secour still maintains an eclectic and cozy feel. Simplicity and southern comfort combine to create a truly unique community. The pace is slow and the fishing is good in Bon Secour, AL!

The area is located in between Foley and Gulf Shores, on the west side of Highway 59. Starting from the Intracoastal Bridge in Gulf Shores it extends north to County Road 10. There are other county highways that lead to Bon Secour including County Road 4, also called Oyster Bay Road, County Road 6, and County Road 8. One can drive to the beach within 10-20 minutes or to the Eastern Shore in about 30 minutes.

The largest of the Eastern Shore towns, and largest in Baldwin County, is Daphne. With a population of nearly 26,000, it has seen a nearly 50 percent increase in the number of residents. It has all you might expect, from banks to grocery stores to a Jubilee festival in the summer, one of the key standouts of this area. To the south is Fairhope, known for its dedication to the arts. This includes a number of galleries featuring local artisans as well as outdoor sculptures.

If it's history you are after, check out Spanish Fort and historic Malbis. The site of a Civil War battlefield, colonial era homes, and Native American homelands dating back thousands of years can all be found in the little town of Spanish Fort, home of the Interstate 10 bridge to Mobile. Named to the National Register of Historic Places, historic Malbis is the site of the glorious Malbis Memorial Greek Orthodox Church and the still-standing structures of a plantation established by Jason Malbis in the early 1900s. When coming to the beach region, be sure to take some time and look at all the riches the Eastern Shore has to offer.



Fairhope includes the Municipal Pier and Park, a nearly 1,500-foot structure jetting into Mobile Bay that is considered Fairhope's "town square." Dating back to 1894 and rebuilt after it was destroyed by Hurricane Katrina, the square welcomes visitors with a park and rose garden, while diners can grab a bite halfway down the pier. It's also a popular spot for walking, fishing, and checking out a pelican or two.



This story of this land dates back to the early 1900s when Jason Malbis came from Chicago to settle this rural area near the eastern shores of Mobile Bay. Born in Greece, Jason started a 10,000-acre plantation that prospered and grew to include farmland, livestock, an electric power plant, an ice plant, and a turpentine still as well as providing the environment for Greek culture to grow. Although much of the plantation land has since been sold some of the original buildings remain, providing a historic record of plantation life in Alabama. The Greek identity of the land also adds to this record, lending to the plantation's listing on the National Register of Historic Places. You don't have to sacrifice your convenience to shopping and dining just to live in a quiet rural area. Recent growth has brought several high-profile retailers into the Malbis area, especially with the development of Eastern Shore Center along AL-181. You can find everything you need within the community, including a Sam's Club, Lowe's Home Improvement, Cracker Barrel, and various other restaurants. Want to see a home in person?

Historic Blakely State Park combines a diverse natural features and an abundance of history. The grounds are the site of the last major battle of the Civil War and also has remnants of the early Alabama town of Blakely, colonial era homes, and Native American settlements going back thousands of years. The bridge to Mobile stretches from the shores of this city, named for a Spanish fort from the Revolutionary war. It's also home to ecological wonders as part of the Mobile Bay Delta.

Spanish Fort has a population of about 8,300, which is an increase of more than a 1,000 from 2010. The small city is known as a bedroom community and it has among the best performing schools in Baldwin County.








